Essential Skills

If you have completed Essential Skills previously or are able to provide suitable evidence, such as GCSE certificates or similar, you may be exempt from completing this element of the qualification.

Qualification Overview

To achieve our Level 3 Barbering qualification, you must complete 66 credits in total:

- 40 credits from the mandatory units
- A minimum of 26 credits from the optional units

Please note that:

- Monthly tutor visits are required and extra visits or support can be provided
- Tutor sessions may last up to two hours
- The qualification will take 15 months to complete
