Essential Skills

Welsh Government is committed to raising the levels of Essential Skills across Wales.

Communication and Application of Number qualifications are an integral element of the funded apprenticeship frameworks.

These are usually delivered through workshops at one of our centres and will be planned well in advance. If you have completed Essential Skills previously or are able to provide suitable evidence, such as GCSE certificates or similar, you may be exempt from completing this element of the qualification.

Qualification Overview

The qualification will take a minimum of 16 months to complete.

To achieve the Level 2 Animal Care qualification, **Welfare pathway**, you must complete a minimum of 44 credits in total:

- Mandatory units 28 credits
- Mandatory optional units 5 credits*
- Optional units a minimum of 11 credits*

To achieve the Level 2 Animal Care qualification, **Dog Grooming pathway**, you must complete a minimum of 48 credits in total:

- Mandatory units 28 credits
- Mandatory optional units 12 credits*
- Optional units a minimum of 8 credits*

To achieve the Level 2 Animal Care qualification, **Pet Care and Retail pathway**, you must complete a minimum of 44 credits in total:

- Mandatory units 28 credits
- Mandatory optional units 8 credits*
- Optional units a minimum of 8 credits*

To achieve the Level 2 Animal Care qualification, **Zoo and Wildlife Establishment pathway**, you must complete a minimum 47 of credits in total:

- Mandatory units 28 credits
- Mandatory optional units 5 credits*
- Optional units a minimum of 14 credits*


